Affordable & Special Needs Housing (ASNH) Funds by Region

For fiscal year 2021

The Affordable and Special Needs Housing (ASNH) program is part of the Housing Innovation Energy Efficiency (HIEE) funds, which are entirely funded through Virginia's participation in the Regional Greenhouse Gas Initiative (RGGI). These funds leverage other financing options to ensure more energy-efficient affordable housing comes to market every day. Whether it's a renovation or brand new construction of multi-family dwellings, these funds provide greater access to healthier and affordable housing for Virginia's most under-served communities.

To date, funds have been awarded to 35 projects across the Commonwealth. The **competitive bidding process** initially prioritized agencies that could immediately jump into action serving their communities. As the program continues, more and more agencies are able to get to work.
